



Brian Caldwell is Principal Consultant at Educational Transformations and Professor Emeritus at the University of Melbourne where he is a former Dean of Education. He was the first person to be appointed to a Personal Chair in Education at this university. Previous academic appointments include Dean of Education at the University of Tasmania. He has held teaching and leadership appointments in schools in Victoria, Australia and Alberta, Canada. He earned a Doctor of Philosophy (1977) from the University of Alberta and was awarded the degree of Doctor of Education *honoris causa* by the Education University of Hong Kong in 2012. International work includes more than 600 presentations, projects and other professional assignments in or for 42 countries or jurisdictions on six continents, with several assignments

for the Asia Development Bank, Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC), OECD, UNESCO, UNICEF and World Bank. He has authored, co-authored or co-edited 19 books, the most recent being *The Autonomy Premium* (2016) and *The Alignment Premium* (2018). He has served as the President of the Australian Council for Educational Leaders (ACEL) and as Deputy Chair of the boards of the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) and the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA).
